

10 Questions Leaders Should Ask About Cybersecurity

How do you know if you are protecting your company's intellectual property?



- 1 What are our most valuable assets? What is ITs' role in securing them?
- 2 Is there adequate protection in place if someone wanted to steal or damage our valuable assets? What is our comfort level with that risk?
- 3 Are we investing enough so that our systems, network and data sources are always up-to-date and not a target for determined hackers?
- 4 Do we actively consider cybersecurity a part of major business decisions and transactions, such as M&A, partnerships, new projects, new tools/software, employees, etc.?
- 5 Are the right skills, technology, vendor partnerships, training and communication plan in place with a clear RACI outline for cybersecurity?
- 6 Do we have the capability to monitor, track and stop inappropriate use of systems or potential security events?
- 7 Is there a documented policy with appropriate controls for use including company systems, resources and data?
- 8 Do we have a cyber-insurance policy and what exactly is covered?
- 9 Are employees trained on threat detection, avoidance and reporting for potential malicious activity? How often is training updated?
- 10 How prepared are we? Can we recover from a cybersecurity incident financially and technically while meeting regulatory requirements?
